2010/2011 REGISTRATION

We will be offering morning and afternoon programs for 2, 3, 4 and 5 year olds. Each class is taught by two co teachers and meets for 2 ½ hours, with the exception of the AM 5s, which has 3 co- teachers and meets for 3 hours. Teacher assignment below may be subject to change.

2 Year-Old Program: Children have the option to meet 2, 3 or 4 days a week in the AM or PM 2s. In most cases there are 8 children per class. Twos and twos/young threes teaching teams are: Mrs. Henk & Mrs. Walther; Mrs. Ricci & Mrs. Carducci; Mrs. Bonner & Mrs. McFarland

3 Year-Old Program: 3s children may attend 3, 4 or 5 days a week, with 12-13 children per class

3/3s Tuesday/Wednesday/Thursday PM: Mrs. Gomez & Ms. Bassett

Because our staff meets regularly for planning purposes, our morning and afternoon sessions have similar goals and activities at each of their respective age levels. The same teachers teach both the AM and PM classes. All children who are currently attending school are guaranteed a place for next year. Students who are currently enrolled in a particular session (AM or PM) will have the first opportunity to enroll in that session for the next year. Placement for any remaining openings in the AM or PM will be determined by several variables, including educational needs and the number of years a family has had children attend RPNS (one point for each year, each child has attended). New Church members and younger siblings should register January 5th and 6th before the Jan. 12th and 13th Interest Meeting for the public. Please be sure to let us know, if you will not be accepting the opening offered to you.

A deposit of 1/6 of the total tuition will be due upon signing the contracts, which you will receive with notification of admission and class selection. This deposit is non refundable and will be applied towards the tuition. Deposit checks will not be accepted without a signed contract. The tuition payment schedule for the 2010/2011 school year will be on May 1st, July 1st, and November 1st. Monthly payments may be arranged through the treasurer, Mary Canneto. Tuition for current students must be paid in full, or all monthly payments must be made through December, before registration for the 2010/2011 school year is accepted. Questions? Scholarships of varying amounts are awarded each March and parents interested in applying should speak to the Director. Recipients are determined by the Board's Scholarship Committee in conjunction with the Director, based on need. Examples of need might include changes in employment or financial status, unexpected medical expenses, multiple tuitions, or any other valid reason. The process is done in strict confidence, with applicants names being known only to the Director and Treasurer. All applications must be completed by March 1, and returned to the Director in a sealed envelope, accompanied with the family's 2009 IRS 1040 and W2.
